LIEUTENANT COLONEL KENNETH S. HARTMAN

Lt. Col. Kenneth S. Hartman is the commander, 169th Logistics Readiness Squadron at McEntire Joint National Guard Base, South Carolina. He leads more than 85 Airmen and civilians, extending support to nearly 1,500 personnel wing-wide which includes over 100 Active Duty Total Force Integration Airmen. His responsibilities include deployment readiness, supplying aircraft and vehicle parts, individual mobility gear, aircraft and ground fuel, maintaining the wing vehicle fleet, and planning all cargo and personnel movements for the largest F-16 fighter wing in the Air National Guard.

Lt. Col. Hartman enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserve in January 1988 as a materials handling specialist for the 312th General Supply Company in Des Moines, Iowa. He transferred to the Iowa Army National Guard, 168th Infantry Battalion in 1993 where he served as a fire team leader before joining the Iowa Air National Guard, 132nd Fighter Wing, Des Moines Air National Guard Base in 1998 as a retail sales specialist. He received his commission from the Academy of Military Science, McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base, Tennessee, in 2002 and was assigned as a logistics readiness officer.



In 2003, he was assigned as an internal review auditor for the USPFO at Camp Dodge, Iowa. In 2006, Hartman served as the 132nd Fighter Wing installation deployment officer. From 2009-2010, he led a joint team in support of operation ENDURING FREEDOM as air director, Combined Joint Special Operations Task Force-Afghanistan at Camp Vance where his team supported over 200 troops-in-contact events and the relief-in-place of 7th and 3rd Special Forces Groups. He was then assigned as 132nd Fighter Wing executive officer in 2011. After completing his master's degree in 2015, he became the director of operations for the 132nd Logistics Readiness Squadron. In 2016, Hartman was assigned as the military personnel management officer for Iowa and served as the J-1 on the Joint Planning Group at Joint Forces Headquarters, Camp Dodge in Johnston, Iowa. Prior to his current position, Lt. Col. Hartman was the commander of the 169th Force Support Squadron.
