Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over

- Drunk driving is illegal and deadly.
- Even a small amount of alcohol can affect driving ability.
- The average DUI costs \$10,000 in attorney's fees, fines, court costs, lost time at work, higher insurance rates, and a potential loss of security clearance.
- The financial impact from impaired-driving crashes is devastating; crashes in which alcohol was the cause resulted in \$57 billion in economic costs.
- If you're caught drinking & driving, you can face jail time, and the arrest will follow you for years to come.



- During the 2019-2023 December months, there were 4,931 people killed in alcohol-impaired-driving crashes.
- In December 2023 alone, 1,038 people died in alcohol-impaired-driving crashes.
- Almost half (47%) of drivers involved in fatal crashes between the hours of midnight and 2:59 a.m. were drunk.
