

## POFs on McEntire JNGB

Visitors/Contractors: **NO** POFs allowed without prior DFC approval.

DoD ID Card Holders: Are authorized to transport a POF onto McEntire JNGB:

- CAC Card (Military & Civilian)
- Retired ID Card
- Dependent ID Card
- Individual Ready Reserve/Inactive NG
- DoD Retired Civilian ID card

### Installation Entry Procedures

- Consistent w/SC §16-23-20(9)(a) it is lawful for a handgun to be in a vehicle, if the handgun is "secured" in a closed glove compartment, closed console, closed trunk, or in a closed container secured by an integral fastener and transported in the luggage compartment of the vehicle.

- Rifle/shotgun: Unloaded & not readily available or within reach of vehicle occupants.

- NO** POFs removed from locked Vehicle.
- NO** Open Carry of POFs allowed.
- NO** Concealed Carry POFs allowed.
- NO** POF carry into any buildings.
- NO** POF carry at outdoor functions.

## LEOSA Carry of Concealed Weapons

- ONLY LEOSA-credentialed individuals can conceal-carry POFs on McEntire JNGB.
- Must have LEOSA credentials vetted by 169 SFS.
- Must read the McEntire JNGB policy and sign memorandum.
- Must have valid LEOSA credentials at all times when they have a POF on McEntire JNGB.
- LEOSA personnel must not be on any "Do Not Arm" rosters.
- LEOSA-credentialed personnel shall not carry a firearm while under the influence of alcohol or another intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance.
- LEOSA credential does not grant any authority to act on the AF or installation's behalf or to exercise any law enforcement authority on McEntire JNGB.

## LEOSA Prohibited Carry

- All PL1, PL2, PL3 Restricted Areas
- Any Base Medical Facility
- Designated Mental Health Offices
- Any area designated off limits by order of the 169 FW/CC or DFC.
- These areas will be identified by a restricted area sign and/or another sign or marker identifying that concealed POFs are not permitted in that area or facility.

## State Issued CWP Holders

- Possession of a state issued CWP does not grant any privilege to carry a concealed firearm while on McEntire JNGB.
- Personnel with a valid CWP must follow safe removal and storage guidance before exiting their vehicle while on McEntire JNGB.

## Contact with Law Enforcement

- Any person stopped for base entry point checks, traffic violations, or for any other reason by law enforcement: must immediately inform that there is a POF in the vehicle or on their person; and must be able to produce:
- DoD ID Card
  - Valid CWP (if applicable)
  - LEOSA credential (if applicable).

## Safe Removal and Storage of POF

While on McEntire JNGB, personnel with a firearm will safely remove and/or secure their POF, before exiting their vehicle, in a discrete manner so as not to cause public alarm or panic.

While on McEntire JNGB, all firearms being temporarily stored in a vehicle that is unoccupied or otherwise unattended, must:

- Remain inside a locked vehicle
- Remain hidden from public view
- Remain in a location where the physical manipulation of a door, hatch, cover is required to access the POF

## Suspension of POF Authority

- The Installation Commander and/or the Defense Force Commander can suspend, revoke or terminate POF authority onto McEntire JNGB at any time.
- Individuals who violate policy or any federal/state firearms laws are subject to criminal prosecution as well as administrative or disciplinary actions.

## UNAUTHORIZED WEAPONS

The Following weapons are prohibited unless government/department issued.

- Any explosive weapon, device, material, etc.
- Switchblade, gravity, automatic release knives
- Swords (excluding ceremonial display)
- Night sticks, black jacks, saps, etc.
- Firearm silencers
- Short Barrel firearms (i.e. <16" rifle / <18" shotguns, or <26" overall length)
- Any other device designed to inflict bodily injury or death
