2019 UNDERGRADUATE PILOT TRAINING BOARD ANNOUNCEMENT

1. The 169 FW will be conducting a UPT Selection Board during June 2019. Submit completed packages to Senior Master Sgt. Steven David (address below) between Feb 1 and Apr 1, 2019—all information should be current as of Feb 1, 2019 (or later).
2. Packages are reviewed by the selection board and approximately 12 candidates will be offered an interview.
3. UPT candidate interviews will take place on Saturday June 8, 2019. Normally one candidate and an alternate will be selected to attend Undergraduate Pilot Training. Interviewees can expect to be notified of the UPT Board results by e-mail within three weeks following the board.
4. Application packages should be submitted electronically as a single PDF (Packages less than 3 MB may be e-mailed, otherwise submit a CD to SCANG Officer Accessions). The following documents are required:
 - a. Cover Letter
 - b. Resume—must include at a minimum: e-mail address, phone number, and education (including GPAs) and work histories starting with high school; a picture is optional, but recommended to associate faces with names
 - c. PCSM Score Sheet—combines flying hours, AFOQT pilot score, and Test of Basic Aviation Skills (TBAS) scores; see <https://pcsm.aetc.af.mil> for schedule
 - d. Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT) Scores
 - e. 169 FW UPT Applicant Questionnaire
 - f. Consolidated college transcript
 - g. Letters of Recommendation (optional, but maximum of three)
 - h. Copies of pilot logbook totals, pilot certificate, FAA medical, etc. (if applicable)
 - i. [Air Force Form 24](#) Application for Appointment as Reserve of the Air Force
 - j. [Air Force Form 2030](#) USAF Drug and Alcohol Abuse Certificate
 - k. Other items as desired to present yourself or make your case
5. A baccalaureate or higher degree from an educational institution listed in the current Accredited Institutions of Post-Secondary Education, or expected graduation date prior to the board, is required for all appointments unless waived.
6. Minimum AFOQT scores are in accordance with [AFI 36-2005](#) (dated 19 May 2003) and [ANGI 36-2005](#) (15 March 2005, Certified Current 22 August 2013):
 - a. Verbal 15, Quantitative 10, Pilot 25, Navigator 10, and Pilot + Navigator at least 50
 - b. An Adjutant General approved education waiver is mandatory for applicants without a college degree. Minimum GPAs are 2.3 (90-104/135-156 semester/quarter hours), 2.2 (105-119/157-179 hours), or 2.1 (120+/180+ hours) with minimum AFOQT scores of Verbal 30, Quantitative 25, Pilot 50, Navigator 25, and Pilot + Navigator at least 90
7. We are looking for highly motivated, self-starters who are committed to the Profession of Arms. You will be serving our great state and nation as a professional officer and fighter pilot. Formal training is a rigorous 2-3 year process with many more years honing your skills to fight America's wars. You are welcome to visit the Fighter Squadron before the board. Prior coordination and Drill weekends tend to work best. Please call SMSgt David to arrange a visit. E-mail is preferred if trying to contact the Fighter Squadron Commander.
